SUMMARY OF DECLINED AND REALLOCATED FUNDS UNDER THE H-GAC METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – MITIGATION FUNDS

After receiving conditional approval from the Texas General Land Office for the preliminary Method of Distribution, the Houston-Galveston Area Council contacted the chief elected official for each local government that would receive an allocation. The letters requested that each entity notify H-GAC of their decision to accept or decline their allocation.

Two entities, the City of Houston and the City of Manvel, declined their allocations.

The reallocation methodology in the conditionally approved Method of Distribution calls for any declined funds to be reallocated to Harris County cities and General Law cities in the region. Cities must receive a minimum of \$900,000 in reallocated funds, using the same formula as the initial allocations, to be eligible. The proposed initial reallocation would be made to the City of Houston, as no other eligible city received a reallocation amount above the minimum threshold, using the same formula and factors as the initial allocations.

If the City of Houston declines this reallocated amount, the reallocations would instead be made to the cities of Baytown, Bellaire, Friendswood, Pasadena, and South Houston.
